

WADPFR Scholarship Application

The Wisconsin Association of Dairy Plant Field Representatives has established a program to offer 3 college scholarships (\$500 each) to students sponsored by a member of the WADPFR.

Criteria for selection:

First preference will be given to those whose parent is a member of WADPFR in any field of study. Next preference will be given to any applicant enrolled in an **agricultural** field of study at a post-secondary college, university or technical school program. Final preference will be given to all other applicants regardless of parent membership in WADPFR or field of study.

Primary criteria for selection of the most qualified candidate will be based upon academic achievement, community service & civic involvement, school activities, work activities, as well as involvement in agriculture related activities.

Instructions and information:

- 1) Obtain an application & two letters of recommendation.
- 2) Submit completed application with a copy of your most recent high school and/or college transcript and ACT test scores. Transcripts do not have to be official.
- 3) Please submit any scanned photos, news articles, etc. related to you being involved in extra-curricular or agricultural activities, community service, or volunteer work.
- 4) You may attach additional pages to the application as necessary.
- 5) Winners will be notified after the scholarship committee has reviewed applications.
- 6) Scholarship payments will be made directly to the winner.
- 7) Deadline for submission of applications is **December 31, 2017**. Please mail completed application by deadline to:
