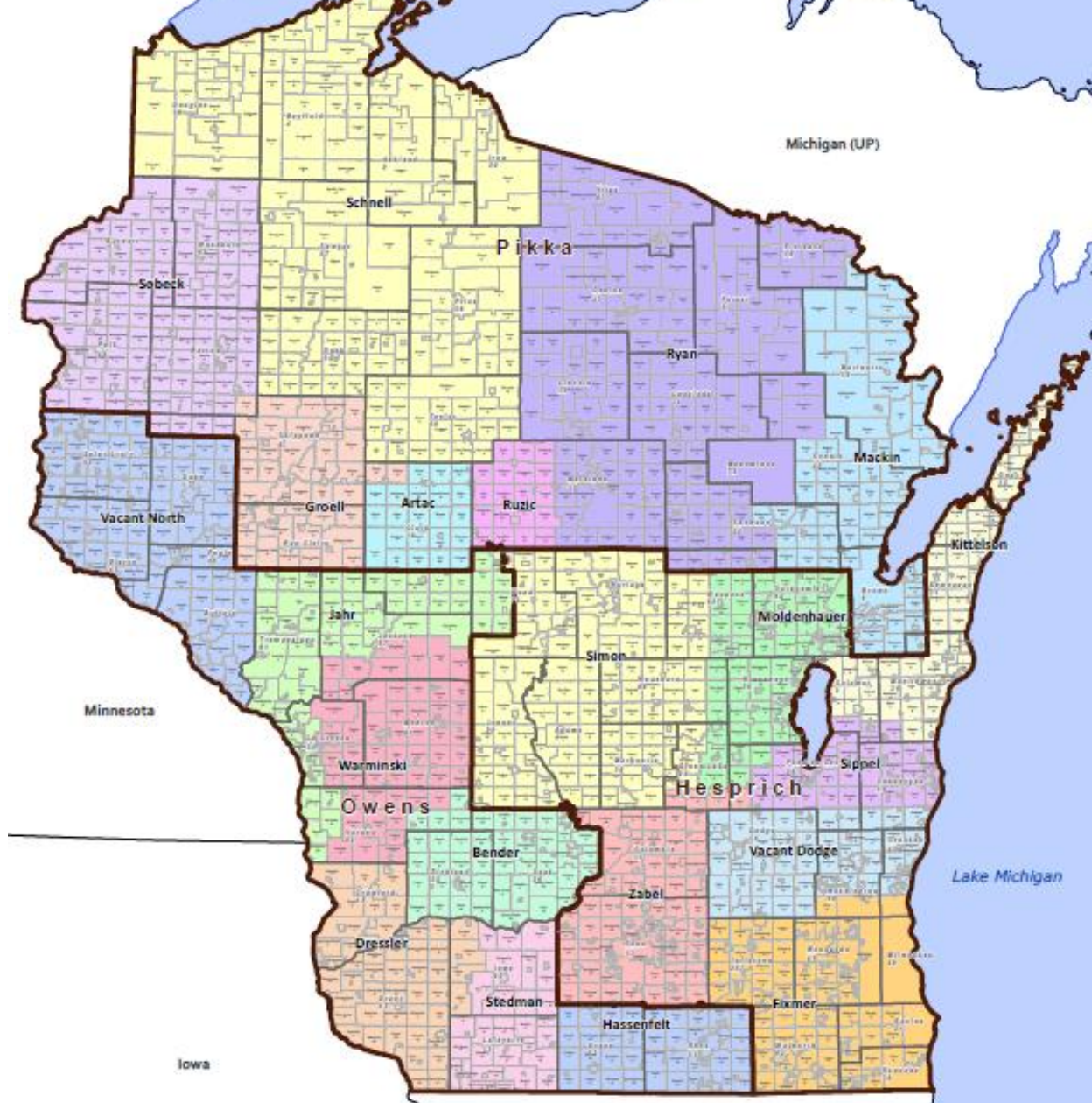

# Temporary Farm Licenses

- ⌘ NOT Preferred- NOT for poor planning
- ⌘ Plant Representative must conduct an inspection prior to submitting application!
- ⌘ License can be denied upon DATCP inspection
- ⌘ Temporary License Applications can be denied

# Farm Enforcement

⌘ Call it as it is

⌘ Jan 17-June 17 = 6907 Routine Grade A Inspections

☒ 802 Reinspections = 12%

☒ 16% NO violations noted

☒ Highest rate= 38%

☒ Lowest rate= 4%

# Performance Based Farm Inspection- Cat 4

- ⌘ Can't stay there >36 months
- ⌘ License will be conditioned
