vs. MSRO's Top 10 Farm
Inspection Violations

Gathering information data

- ▶ Dairy Sanitarians: I gathered data for the past 18 months starting July 2015.
- ▶ MSRO's: I randomly selected 10 farm surveys from the current MSRO's within the past 12 months.

Results from the data collection

▶ NUMBER 10

- ▶ Sanitarians: Debit #60 Milk and equipment properly protected
- ▶ MSRO's: Debit #32 No trash, unnecessary articles, animals or fowl

Results from the data collection

▶ NUMBER 9

- ▶ Sanitarians: Debit #19 Approved materials and finish (M.H. or Room - Walls & Ceilings)
- ▶ MSRO's: Debit #75 Surroundings neat and clean, free of harborages and breeding areas

Results from the data collection

▶ NUMBER 8

- ▶ Sanitarians: Debit #32 No trash, unnecessary articles, animals or fowl
- ▶ MSRO's: Debit #50 Single-service articles properly stored

Results from the data collection

▶ NUMBER 7

- ▶ Sanitarians: Debit #50 Single-service articles properly stored
- ▶ MSRO's: Debit #31 Floors, walls, windows, tables, and similar non-product contact surfaces clean

Results from the data collection

▶ NUMBER 6

- ▶ Sanitarians: Debit #16 Smooth; concrete or other impervious material; in good repair
- ▶ MSRO's: Debit #16 Smooth; concrete or other impervious material; in good repair

Results from the data collection

▶ NUMBER 5

- ▶ Sanitarians: Debit #05 Walls and ceilings smooth, painted or finished adequately; in good repair; ceiling dust-tight
- ▶ MSRO's: Debit #46 Utensils and equipment clean

Results from the data collection

▶ NUMBER 4

- ▶ Sanitarians: Debit #61 Proper hand-washing facilities convenient to milking operations
- ▶ MSRO's: Debit #60 Milk and equipment properly protected

Results from the data collection

▶ NUMBER 3

- ▶ Sanitarians: Debit #71 All milkhouse openings effectively screened or otherwise protected; doors tight and self-closing; screen doors open outward
- ▶ MSRO's: Debit #05 Walls and ceilings smooth, painted or finished adequately; in good repair; ceiling dust tight

Results from the data collection

▶ NUMBER 2

- ▶ Sanitarians: Debit #31 Floors, walls, windows, tables, and similar non-product contact surfaces clean
- ▶ MSRO's: Debit #40 No connection between safe and unsafe supplies; no improper submerged inlets

Results from the data collection

▶ NUMBER 1

- ▶ Sanitarians: Debit #10 Clean and free of litter
(Milking barn, Stable or Parlor -
Cleanliness)
- ▶ MSRO's: Debit #10 Clean and free of litter
(Milking barn, Stable or Parlor -
Cleanliness)

Results of our Top 10 Violations

- ▶ 7 out of 10 were written up by both the sanitarians and the MSRO's and those Debit numbers were:
10, 31, 05, 16, 50, 32 & 60
- ▶ The other Debts in the top 10 we did not match on were:
By Sanitarians were: 71, 61 & 19
By MSRO's were: 40, 46 & 75

In Conclusion

- ▶ Even though the Sanitarians and the MSRO's are enforcing different rules (PMO vs ACTP 65) it shows how close the two (2) programs are.
- ▶ There still is some differences between the PMO and ATCP 65, we are identifying them and telling our sanitarians and MSRO's what they are.

In Conclusion

- ▶ We are asking our sanitarians and MSRO's to help educate the producers on what the differences are.
- ▶ And what they need to do to attain a good inspection.
