# The confusion of labeling

1. If it is an approved drug, makes a claim, and is used according to label or ELU-acceptable
2. Topical exemption: if it is not labeled for cattle, no banned substances, is a topical antiseptic or wound dressing and labeled/packaged/administered as such-acceptable
  - ▶ Blue-Kote
  - ▶ Koppertox
3. Unapproved substance: no banned substances, makes a claim and is unapproved substance- violation
  - ▶ Gold Strike
4. Unapproved substance with no claim: no banned substances, is unapproved, and is labeled, packaged, and administered either orally or topically
  - ▶ Examples of acceptable-if administered correctly
    - ▶ Cellex Gold
    - ▶ Yellow Jacket
  - ▶ Examples of those in violation
    - ▶ Whey extract- packaged in as injectable
    - ▶ Utersept RTU- label states to infuse
